Help us to make places, events, and people come alive again!

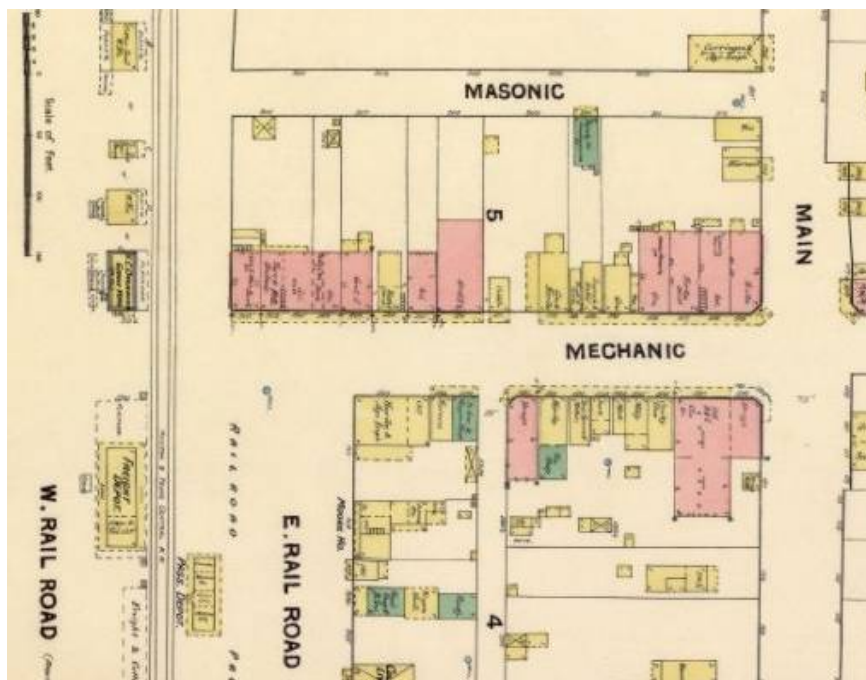
Campaign Updates
